

ORDINANCE NO. 1917

AN ORDINANCE SETTING OUT BOATING REGULATIONS AT THE COUNCIL GROVE LAKE PARK AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREFORE, AMENDING AND REPEALING ORDINANCE No. 1873.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL GROVE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Water Craft Restrictions. Any and all water craft, including boats, personal water crafts, rafts, or other manmade floating devices being used on the Council Grove Lake Park are to travel in a counter-clockwise direction on the Council Grove Lake Park.

SECTION 2. Prohibited Maneuvers. No water craft shall maneuver in small circles, nor stop or turn sharply, except in case of emergency, to pick up a fallen skier or to retrieve someone in the lake.


SECTION 3. Area of Operation/Creation of Waves. All water craft which create a wake are to be operated in the main body of the Council Grove Lake, inside the area demarcated by buoys.


SECTION 4. Penalties. Any person operating or under the control of a water craft which is in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined a minimum of \$100.00 up to a maximum of \$500.00 for a first offense. Upon a second offense, the minimum fine shall be \$150.00 up to a maximum fine of \$500.00 and the boating privileges of such offender may be revoked for the remainder of the year. Upon a third or subsequent offense, the minimum fine shall be \$300.00 up to a maximum fine of \$500.00 and the boating privileges of such offender shall be revoked for the remaining portion of the year.

SECTION 5. Repeal. Ordinance No. 1873 and any and all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its publication in the Council Grove Republican, the official city newspaper.
