

COUNCIL GROVE CITY LAKE ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

In 2017, the Council Grove City Lake Association (CGCLA) Board of Directors established a scholarship program for high school seniors whose families are members of the CGCLA. Each year since, the CGCLA has awarded a \$500 scholarship. Each applicant must be an immediate family member (children/grandchildren) of a CGCLA resident. The scholarships will be awarded as follows:

The scholarship is based on academic achievement and leadership qualities/activities. Letters of recommendation and a resume` from the applicant will also be considered. The scholarship can be used for any post high school education including college, junior college, or trade schools/vo-tech. The minimum Grade Point Average required for eligibility is 3.0 GPA based upon a 4.0 grading scale.

An applicant must be a member in good standing with the school in which they attend and sponsored by a current member of the Council Grove City Lake Association. The CGCLA Scholarship Committee will make the selection of the students to receive the awards. No student shall be eligible for any scholarship if their parent or grandparent serves on of the CGCLA Scholarship Committee. The scholarship committee will be made up of members of the Council Grove City Lake Association and shall be appointed from a pool by the CGCLA president.

Scholarship applications are attached to this email and are also available on our website cgclakeassoc.org under 2025 Scholarship Applications. Scholarship applications must be returned to the Council Grove City Lake Association by April 15, 2025 with the winner announced on May 1. Any scholarship application not completed in its entirety, including all required attachments, will be disqualified. Scholarship winners will be asked to submit a photograph for posting on the CGCLA website and newsletter, invited to attend the next monthly CGCLA meeting and participate in a photo shoot for the press.

Completed applications must be received by April 15, 2025. Applicants may submit their applications by mail or by email.
