

ORDINANCE NO. 2156

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF BOAT AS IT RELATES TO BOATING FEES AND REQUIREMENTS AT THE COUNCIL GROVE LAKE PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL GROVE, KANSAS:

Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the definition of "boat" so that water craft propelled by oars or paddles will no longer be subject to boat registration fees and aquatic nuisance species education courses.

Section 2. CURRENT DEFINITION. As set forth in Section 2D of Ordinance No. 2059 boat is defined as follows:

D. Boat. "Boat" means any vessel that is required to be registered by the State of Kansas as well as any water craft designed to be propelled by machinery, oars, paddles or wind action upon a sail for navigation on water.


Section 3. NEW DEFINITION. Following the effective date of this ordinance, boats shall be defined as follows:

D. Boat. "Boat" shall mean any vessel that is required to be registered by the State of Kansas as well as any water craft designed to be propelled by machinery or wind action upon a sail for navigation on the water.


Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be effective on January 1, 2015.

Section 5. REPEALED. Upon this effective date, Section 2D of Ordinance 2059 is hereby repealed.
