

ORDINANCE NO. 2001

AN ORDINANCE DEALING WITH BOATING SAFETY AND THE REQUIREMENTS  
OF COAST GUARD APPROVED LIFE PRESERVERS FOR BOATS  
UPON THE WATERS AT THE COUNCIL GROVE LAKE PARK.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL  
GROVE, KANSAS:

Section 1. PURPOSE. The purpose of the ordinance is to bring city ordinance in  
conformance with current state law.


Section 2. BOAT SAFETY; LIFE PRESERVERS. All children 12 years of age and  
younger must wear coast guard-approved life preservers when a boat is in use upon the waters of  
the Council Grove City Lake. All skiers and surfboard riders must wear coast guard-approved  
life preservers. All persons over 12 years of age are not required to wear life preservers when  
upon the waters of the Council Grove Lake Park, but are to have available approved coast guard  
life preservers for each occupant of the boat.

Section 3. PENALTY. The general penalty provisions of Section 1-116 of Ordinance  
No. 1820 shall be applicable to violators of this ordinance.


Section 4. REPEAL. Section 12-629 of Ordinance No. 1820 of the ordinances of the  
City of Council Grove, Kansas is hereby repealed.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective upon its publication in  
the Council Grove Republican.
