

ORDINANCE NO. 2179

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL GROVE, KANSAS, AND WITHIN THE COUNCIL GROVE LAKE PARK, INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2016, PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COUNCIL GROVE, KANSAS:

Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Council Grove, Kansas, within the Council Grove Lake Park, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2016, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 2179," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the city, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.


Section 2. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall be as set forth in that fine schedule. Otherwise it shall not be less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00.

Section 3. SECTIONS OMITTED. Sections 114.1, 114.2 and 114.4 are hereby omitted and deleted.


Section 4. REPEAL. Ordinance 2158 is hereby repealed.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the Council Grove Republican.
